The week of February 5, 2012

Look up the following verses, meditate on them,
and answer the questions.

DAY #1 – Romans 8:28-31

What did you learn from Sunday's message about the connection of this great promise with God's sovereignty?

Why should this give us great comfort?

How does this relate to seeking God's will of direction?

DAY #2 – Psalm 40:4-8

Which aspects for discerning God's will, that we have already examined, appear in these verses?

What do you learn about Jesus' approach to God's will in verse 8 of this Messianic Psalm?

Where does this challenge you in your life?

DAY #3 – Ephesians 5:15-21

According to Sunday's message, which of these commandments did Paul model in his life?

How is being sensitive to the Holy Spirit's leading related to our circumstances in discerning God's will?

DAY #4 – Read the quote from F.B. Myer.

"Whenever you are doubtful as to your course, submit your judgment absolutely to the Spirit of God, and ask Him to shut against you every door but the right one.....In the meantime, continue along the path which you have been already treading. It lies in front of you; pursue it.

Abide in the calling in which you are called. Keep on as you are unless you are clearly told to do something else. Expect to have as clear a door out as you had in; and if there is no indication to the contrary, consider the absence of indication to be the indication of God's will that you are on His track."

Circle the part that is most meaningful to you and ask the Lord to direct you through this.

DAY #5 – Acts 19:23-41

What was the source of the opposition that Paul faced?

What did Paul do to create such a commotion?

How does this relate to discerning God's will through circumstances according to 1 Corinthians 16:8-9?
